**STORUMAN'S MOST VISITED PLACE**  
The popular vantage point can be reached on foot, by bicycle or by car via the Utsiktsvägen (also known as Björn Ferry's path) in the direction to Stenseleberget. From the lookout tower you can enjoy the wonderful view over lake Storuman far into the mountains to Hemavan and Tärnaby. The small café in the cosy cottage is occasionally open. Furthermore, you can treat yourself with freshly baked waffles with cloudberry jam or a typical Swedish fika!

Homesteads and cultural areas

**CHURCHES, PARKS AND MUSEUMS**  
On **Luspholmarna** is Storuman's homestead, an area with cultural buildings and a museum. A bakery with a wood fired oven is available for rent if you want to bake your own flatbread or maybe a pizza.  
**The homestead in Stensele** was built at the end of the 1840s. There you will find historical utensils from the old days to look at. Nowadays midsummer is celebrated on the large lawns below the house where the river Umeälven passes through the area. A bakery with an electric oven is here available to rent if you want to bake.  
**In Stensele** is Sweden's largest wooden church, Lapland Cathedral built in 1886 with contemporary furnishings and seating for around 2000 people. In the church you can admire a mechanical choir organ with ten stops and the smallest bible in the world with the size of a quarter of a post stamp.  
**Gunnarn** was visited by Carl Linnaeus in 1732. In memory of his visit, was the Linnépark laid out. In the park there are plants related to his visit and a statue of Linéé is placed there by the residents.  
The museum in **Gunnarn's old school**, built in 1905, has a photo exhibition with a flea market and some antiques. The building offers us the opportunity to see local, historical objects, which give us information about the development of the area's history.  
**Umnäs** has a rural museum with Sami and settler culture, a school museum, and some old photographs. Here you will also find a large collection of newspaper clippings from the area over the years. A real treasure for those who are interested in genealogical research. You will also find a church in Umnäs.  
**In Slussfors**, we recommend a visit to the Esso Nostalgic petrol station.

**In Åskilje** there is a wooden church built in 1925-1928 with a pulpit made in the 17th century.



**Längsjöby** gives you the opportunity to discover a unique and restored mill area, the mills with many cultural relics of the environment. Among other things, you can see the mill pond, the horizontal wheel of the water mill, resting huts, logger huts and summer cottages.


Hiking, sport and motion

**STORUMAN LAPLAND OFFERS MANY OPPORTUNITIES TO EXERCISE**  
**Hike** along the accessible beach promenade close to the centre or follow the church path from Storuman to Stensele in the forest. **ANOTHER TIP** is called "bike cord" - a rather easy trail in a lovely forest, which leads you along the north side of Gunnarbäcken, perfect for cross country cycling. In the village of Barsele there is a lookout with wind breaks, an easier hike for the whole family. Through the village is also leading a walking path over cut meadows.  
**Bring your roller skis** or your inline skates to Stensele and enjoy a few training laps on the paved roller ski track that leads you through the pine forest.  
**Challenge yourself** and climb three of our highest mountain peaks in the near vicinity of Storuman - Kyrkberget, Utsiktsberget and Forsviksberget. Or if you drive to the mountain Gippmökobben for a more challenging summit hike. Up there you will be rewarded with a wonderful view of the surrounding mountains, lakes and forest landscapes.  
**Rent a bike** and explore the local areas or try kayaking on one of the many lakes. Challenge your friends on boules, do some work out at the Peak gym & fitness or try the outdoor gym by the lake Badsjön.  
**Play golf at** Gunnarn Golf course which is beautifully situated on a hilly landscape surrounded by ponds and open farmland. Info: [gunnarn.golf.se](http://gunnarn.golf.se)  
There are **outdoor** gyms in Storuman and in Slussfors.


Fun for the whole family

Storuman Lapland provides many outdoor activities with different themes for active families.  
There are **playgrounds** for younger as well as older visitors in Storuman, but also in the smaller villages of Slussfors, Barsele and in Gunnarn.  
**The multi-arena** in Storuman has a newly built artificial turf for ball sports, obstacle course and outdoor curling. A fenced area is available for dogs, so your dog is also free to move around. A packed lunch can be taken to one of the picnic places in the area.  
**Storuman's camping** is located directly next to the lake, which offers you a selection of land and water activities. You can try minigolf, pedal boating, SUP boards, tennis and much more. It is also nice to take a stroll to the lake and play trimbongo or why not try the fun sport disc golf?


**FISHING CARD**

The fishing map contains a lot of information about fishing conservation areas and other things you may need to know, if you want to fish here. Ask for the fishing map at the Tourist information or in one of the shops where you can buy fishing equipment and fishing licenses.

Swimming places

All around Storuman Lapland you will find the opportunity to take a refreshing swim in one of the clean and clear lakes. It is easy to find your own favourite place where you can enjoy the splendid nature undisturbed.

**STORUMAN** **Badsjön** Swimming lake with diving platform, jetties, outdoor shower, activities, sandy beaches playground etc.  
**Luspholmarna** with several smaller swimmer friendly sandy beaches on various islands.  
**Hembygdsgården** – sandy beaches with sunbathing area, outside toilet.  
**A TIP:** Behind the estate leads a path to a small beach where you are often undisturbed.  
**STENSELE** **Boxan** with a jetty with swings, slide, lawns, volleyball, changing rooms and outdoor toilet.  
**GUNNARN** **Lapplaya** – a green area, sandy beaches, jetties, raft, swings, slide, changing rooms, outdoor toilet.  
**LÄNGSJÖBY** **Långvattnet**, sandy beach.  
**ANKARSUND** **Fishing and outdoor camp** - a sandy beach and a barbecue area  
**GRUNDFORS** A jetty, a barbecue area with firewood and changing rooms  
**SKARVSJÖBY** Changing rooms and barbecue area  
**SLUSSFORS** Changing rooms and barbecue area  
**NORRBERG** Shelter from the wind, changing room, a barbecue area, some jetties, outdoor toilet  
**GRANNÄS** Shelter, jetty, and a barbecue area with firewood

**Right of public access**  
**DO NOT DISTURB – DO NOT DESTROY**  
**Tips to keep in mind when visiting us and our region**  
✓ Leave the car at home and rather take the bicycle if you want to discover a new favourite place.  
✓ Nature is more beautiful without waste. Always pack a bag for rubbish and leftovers so you won't leave anything behind.  
✓ Dog waste bags are always good to have – for lots of different things. You are welcome to bring your dog with you but keep it on a leash so it can't disturb the wild animals.  
✓ If you need to relieve yourself in the countryside, you can dig a pit, away from any campsite or walking trail. When you are finished, bury, burn or take the toilet paper with you so it does not become litter.  
✓ If you want to start a fire do so in designated areas and consider the risk of fire
