On arriving in Storuman Lapland you will meet our Wildman. A statue of a man of the woods standing tall and proud, and a symbol for Lapland has been central when promoting Storuman Lapland for the past 30 years.

Local community groups work closely with the municipality to maintain cross-country ski trails, ice rinks, skislope, trails, outdoor gym and playparks. All facilities are available to the general public for free.

Lake Storuman is Sweden's third deepest plunging to a depth of 148 m. From the view tower on top of Stenseleberget hill it is possible to take in the spectacular views over the huge lake, rolling forested landscape and, on clear days, 11 mountain tops far in the distance.

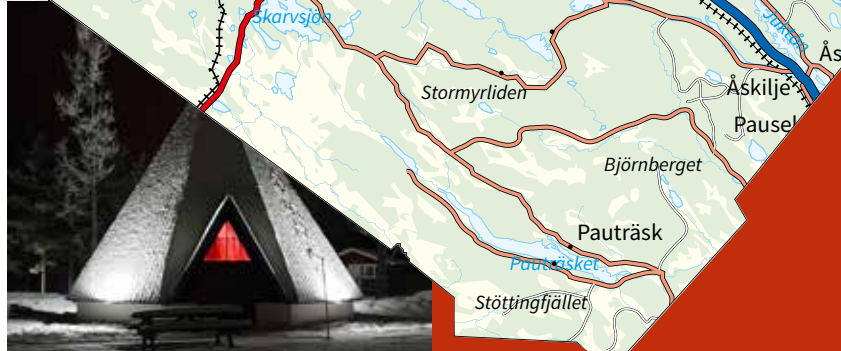
Live, eat, shop
